I, RICHARD BRUTON, Minister for Jobs, Enterprise and Innovation, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 3 of the European Communities Act 1972 (No. 27 of 1972) and for the purpose of giving further effect to Regulation (EC) No 2006/2004 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 October 2004¹ as amended by Regulation (EU) No 181/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 February 2011², hereby make the following regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the European Communities (Cooperation between National Authorities Responsible for the Enforcement of Consumer Protection Laws) (Amendment) (No.2) Regulations 2013.

2. In these Regulations, “Regulations of 2013” means the European Communities (Cooperation between National Authorities Responsible for the Enforcement of Consumer Protection Laws) (Amendment) Regulations 2013 (S.I. No. 122 of 2013).

3. The European Communities (Cooperation between National Authorities Responsible for the Enforcement of Consumer Protection Laws) Regulations 2006 (S.I. No. 290 of 2006) are amended—

(a) in Regulation 2(1) (amended by Regulation 3(a) of the Regulations of 2013) by substituting the following definition for the definition of “Council Regulation”:

“ ‘Council Regulation’ means Regulation (EC) No 2006/2004 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 October 2004 on cooperation between national authorities responsible for the enforcement of consumer protection laws¹ as amended by Directive 2009/136/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 25 November 2009³, Regulation (EU) No 1177/2010 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 24 November 2010⁴, Regulation (EU) No 181/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 February 2011², and Regulation (EU)

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Instrument and does not purport to be a legal interpretation)

These regulations amend S. I. No. 290 of 2006 on Cooperation between National Authorities responsible for the Enforcement of Consumer laws. The regulations implemented Regulation (EC) 2006/2004 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 October 2004 by designating competent authorities to carry out the functions of information exchange, cooperation and infringement proceedings in respect of specified EU consumer Directives/Regulations.

S. I. No. 290 of 2006 is amended in order to designate competent authorities for a new regulation, which was not provided for in the original regulations.

The National Transport Authority is designated for the purpose of Regulation (EU) No 181/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 February 2011 concerning the rights of passengers when travelling by bus and coach Transport.
