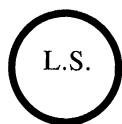

I, PHIL HOGAN, Minister for the Environment, Community and Local Government, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 5(1A) of the Electoral Act 1997 (No. 25 of 1997) inserted by section 23 of the Electoral, Local Government and Planning and Development Act 2013 (No. 27 of 2013), hereby order as follows:

1. This order may be cited as the European Parliament Constituencies Committee (Establishment) Order 2013.

2. A committee is hereby established to perform the function assigned to it by section 5(1A) of the Electoral Act 1997 (No. 25 of 1997) inserted by section 23 of the Electoral, Local Government and Planning and Development Act 2013 (No. 27 of 2013).

This number will be 11 in Ireland.
