CREDIT INSTITUTIONS RESOLUTION FUND LEVY (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS 2018

I, PASCHAL DONOHOE, Minister for Finance, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 15 of the Central Bank and Credit Institutions (Resolution) Act 2011 (No. 27 of 2011), having consulted with the Central Bank of Ireland and the Credit Union Advisory Committee, hereby make the following regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Credit Institutions Resolution Fund Levy (Amendment) Regulations 2018.

2. The Credit Institutions Resolution Fund Levy Regulations 2012 (S.I. No. 381 of 2012) (amended by the Credit Institutions Resolution Fund Levy (Amendment) Regulations 2017 (S.I. No. 433 of 2017) are amended—

(a) in Regulation 2—

(i) in paragraph (1), by the substitution of the following definition for the definition of “levy period”:

“ ‘levy period’ means the period commencing on 1 October 2018 and ending on 30 September 2019.”, and

(ii) in paragraph (3), by the substitution of “30 June 2018” for “30 June 2017”,

(b) in Regulation 3(1), by the substitution of “1 October 2018” for “1 October 2017”, and

(c) in Regulation 4(1), by the substitution of “28 February 2019” for “29 February 2018”.
