PHOENIX PARK ACT 1925 REGULATIONS 2008.

I, MICHAEL F. MURPHY, Commissioner of the Garda Síochána, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 9(2) of the Phoenix Park Act 1925 (No. 31 of 1925) hereby make the following Regulations:

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Phoenix Park Act 1925 Regulations 2008.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 2005 (No. 23 of 2005) applies to these Regulations.
2. Motor cars, carriages, carts and other vehicles and horses shall not—
 - (a) enter the Park through the gate known as the Islandbridge Gate.
 - (b) exit the Park through the gate known as Chapelizod Gate.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This note is not part of the Instrument and does not purport to be a legal interpretation).

These Regulations provide that motor cars, carriages, carts and other vehicles and horses shall not—

- (b) exit the Park through the gate known as Chapelizod Gate.
